

Faux Dry Embossing



Supplies: Cardstock of your choice. My card base was SU Kiwi Kiss and the mat SU Whisper White; white stamp pad (I used SU Craft White) and Kiwi Kiss pad. A STAMP POSITIONER IS A MUST!

Method: Cut all your layers. Stamp your main image and your background image once onto the acrylic/acetate sheet that comes with your stamp positioner. Let dry. Stamp your background, main image and greeting in white ink on card base and focal layer(s). Let dry. Using your stamp positioner, place the stamped image over the image on your card and gently move the acrylic/acetate sheet so that it is a hair to the right/left (depending whether you're left- or right-handed) and a hair above. Remove the acrylic and stamp image with Kiwi Kiss over the top of your white image. Your end result will look like you've dry embossed it.
