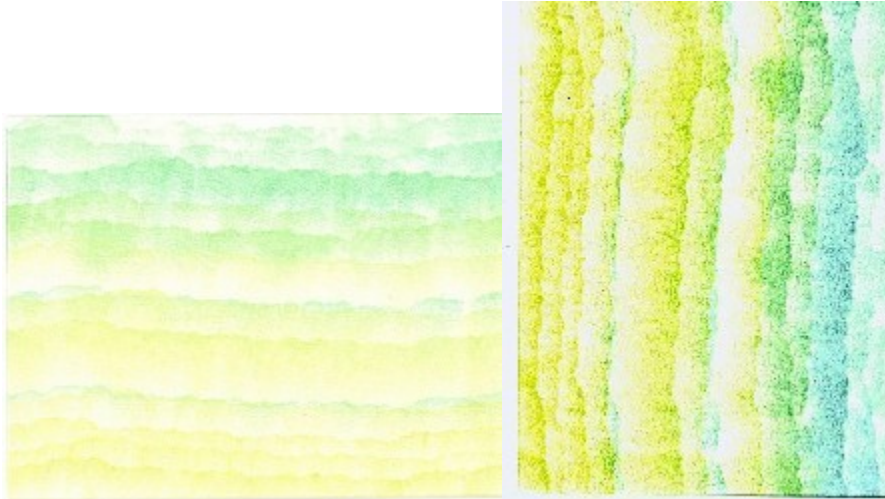


Chalk Dragging

Rip a sheet of paper into a length that is longer than your card. Heavily cover the torn edge with chalk. Place the torn edge on your card in the desired direction of the tear. With your fingertip or an applicator, drag the chalk from the tear onto your card. Move the torn cardstock slightly and repeat the chalking and dragging as necessary to achieve the look you desire. Lightly seal with a spray sealer (I use Krylon) or cheap hairspray to prevent the chalk from smearing.

Note: I like to use several hues of one color and slightly move the torn sheet so that the pattern is not the same all the way across. I prefer to chalk on construction paper as it holds more chalk and is sturdier.
