

Mock Stained Glass Card
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Supplies:

Double stick paper
Acetate
Tiny glass beads
Tissue paper
3 colors of re-inkers
Diamond Glaze
Card and envelope



Measure and cut double sticky paper and acetate slightly smaller than card size. On the acetate, spread Diamond Glaze. On top of diamond glaze, drop dots of each color re-inker, then smear them around until colors are intermingled (not muddy). Place tissue paper on top of this, and press down firmly. Set aside to dry. While ink is drying on acetate, position double sticky paper on front side of card, pressing down. After ink on acetate is dry, cut the piece of acetate in irregular shapes and sizes. Take the pieces of cut acetate, and randomly place on top of double sticky paper, leaving a border around the outside edges, and “streets” between the pieces. Be sure shiny side of acetate is up before you place it on the double stick paper. They will stick down tight, so try not to have to remove any pieces.

For the next step, place card in shallow dish, and pour beads to cover the “streets” and borders. Press beads down to completely cover adhesive paper. (Shallow dish allows you to easily re-group beads and return to their container. Mount this piece on your card.
