

Spinner Card

Materials:

Base Cardstock (5 ½" x 8 ½"), folded in half

Coordinating cardstock (5" x 2 ½")

Small piece of cardstock for spinning image

2 Pennies

5 Dimensional Pop Dots

1 Glue Dot

Word Window Punch (optional)



Fold base cardstock in half to create card – stamp as you wish.

Stamp coordinating cardstock (5" x 2 ½") as you wish.

Using Word Window Punch (StampinUp!) punch out a solid line across middle of cardstock (I punched 3 times). Or, if you do not have the punch, cut out a rectangle in the middle of your cardstock that is wide enough to accommodate your dimensional pop dot (word window punch is 3/8" wide). Stamp a smaller design (big enough to cover your penny) and cut out. Adhere a pop dot to one of your pennies.

Your supplies should look like this...



Now, adhere four pop dots to each corner on the back side of the piece of cardstock that has the rectangle cut out. Place the penny with the pop dot in the rectangle from the back side of cardstock so it looks like this...



Place other penny on top of pop dot from the front side of cardstock and then layer your small stamped image on top of the front penny using a glue dot. Adhere the rectangle piece of cardstock to your base card (it needs to be applied using the dimensional pop dots so that the penny will have room to spin). Tilt your card back and forth and watch it spin!

Love stamp – StampinUp!; Hugs & Kisses stamp – Rubber Stampede; Trio of Hearts stamp – Hero Arts; Die cut heart – Sizzix
