Spotlight Stamping is a technique used to highlight a specific part of a stamped image.

1. Stamp your image two separate times on card stock. One image will be left as is, the second image will be used for your "spotlight".

2. Decide which area of you would like to "spotlight" and cut that portion out of your second image. Your "spotlight" can be any shape and any size.

3. Color your "spotlight" section and match it up to the first image and attach. The "spotlight" can be attached with glue or foam tape. You can choose to add a coordinating piece of paper between the images.

4. Layer and attach your images to a card front and you are finished!
