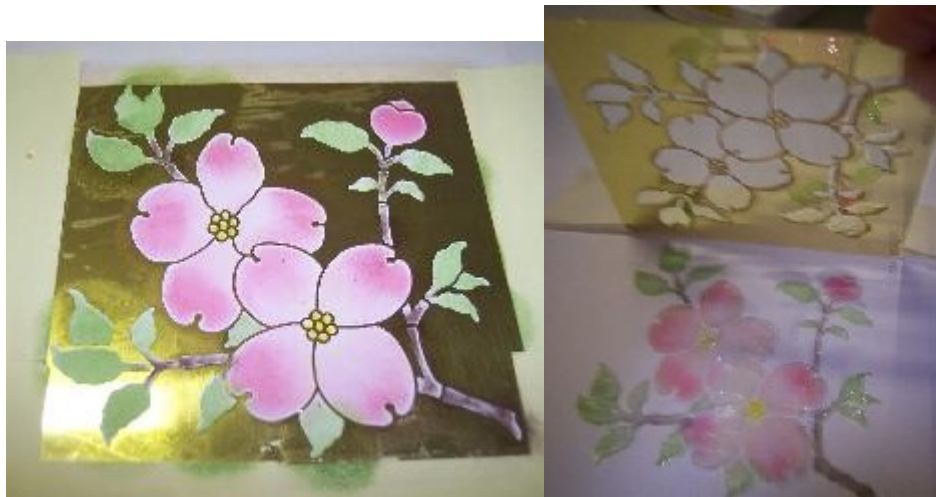


Using Embossing Paste With Stencils

1. Tape the top of the stencil to your paper using removable tape. Then cover all the rest of the area with post it notes so none of the paste gets onto your work where you don't want it. (see photo)
2. Color the image with ink or chalk. You could also probably use color pencils but marker don't work very good. Also you can leave it white if that's the effect you're after. (see photp)
3. Spread a thin, even layer of Dreamweaver Translucent Embossing Paste over the entire area. Make sure all of the areas inside the stencil are covered evenly. (see photo)
4. Remove the post it notes and then carefully lift up the stencil from the bottom and remove the stencil and removable tape all at once. Do this very carefully so as not to smudge the stencil paste.
5. Glitter the entire area and tap the extra glitter off. Use a translucent glitter like Dazzling Diamonds.
6. Let dry thoroughly and then use to mount to a card.
