

Tag Bags

Tags (sizzix die cut tags work well for this project)

matching cs for bag sides

adhesive

ribbon to tie the top

Cut a piece of the cs so that it is the width of your tags and the length you want each of your bag sides to be. Cut it the width you want your bag to be. Generally this is also the width of the tag plus a half inch. Score in one quarter inch on both of the long sides. Stamp and decorate your cs at the point. Find the middle of your long piece and line it up with the middle of your tag. Score at each edge of your tag so that you have a U shape. Fold along the score on the long edge. This will be where you apply your adhesive to attach the sides and bottom to your tags. You may want to trim some out of the corners to make the corners less bulky. After you have adhered to sides and bottom to both tags, pinch a little pleat into each side, fill with tissue or shreds and candy or treats. Draw the tops together and tie a ribbon through the tag holes and your tag bag is complete!
